Admission includes all rides and attractions, picnic tables, and inner tubes. You may enter/exit throughout the day with official stamp and valid receipt. Children 10 years of age and younger must be directly accompanied by a responsible guardian (16 years of age or older).

IN-DISTRICT: Residents must produce valid identification to receive reduced fee. In-District residents live within Ward 4, District 2 Recreation District and/or Sulphur High School Zone, or a property owner of said area.

Plan ahead to save money and time! 30 Visit Punch Cards are available for purchase seasonally, specifically May 5 through July 31. Available for purchase at SPAR WATERPARK and SPAR Recreation & Aquatic Center. Ideal for large families or groups. Each person enter = one punch off card. Use your 30 Visit Punch Card each visit of the 2009 season and never wait in admission line! Allow staff to check your bag and validate the punch card, then off you go to splash, ride, and play. Not replaceable if lost or stolen. Non-refundable.

Qualifications to purchase a SPAR WATERPARK Season Pass are as follows: must be an In-District Resident and an Annual Member of the SPAR Recreation & Aquatic Center. Family members listed on SPAR Recreation & Aquatic Center Membership must match family members on SPAR WATERPARK Season Pass. It is an additional \$20 (\$21.80 with tax) per additional family member's 2009 SPAR WATERPARK Season Pass.

Rules & Regulations

OUTSIDE FOOD POLICY

SPAR WATERPARK does not permit outside food or beverage inside the park; a few exceptions:

Bottled water

Baby food in plastic containers

If you have extenuating circumstance concerning dietary needs, please speak to SPAR Manager.

For your convenience concessions are available on site. (i.e. pizza, subs, nachos, candy, cokes, etc.)

For your safety the following items are not permitted inside SPAR WATERPARK:

Alcoholic beverages or tobacco products (designated smoking area is 25 feet of park entrance), glass containers, firearms, knives, pepper sprays, flammable liquids.

ALL bags are checked at front entrance of the park.

WHAT TO WEAR

- Appropriate swim attire is required at this family centered waterpark (i.e. no bathing suit thongs or undergarments used as swim suit.)
- Swim attire with rivets, buckles or exposed metal is not permitted on the water attractions.
- One-piece swimsuits are recommended on the more thrilling waterslides, like the GREEN MONSTER / BLUE DRAGON attractions.
- Wearing water shoes is a good idea when visiting SPAR WATERPARK; the ground can get hot and so will your feet!
- Persons in diapers are required to wear special swim diapers. Regular diapers are unsanitary and unsafe for any waterpark environment. Swim diapers are available for purchase at ticket counter or the HUT for only a buck.
- Wearing sunscreen is strongly advised. Sunscreen, lip balm, waterproof canisters, waterproof cameras, and other sundries are available for purchase at the HUT.

Attractions



Blue Dragon Body Slide: A fast and looping body slide that splashes sliders into the Lagoon Pool. Sliders must be 42" tall or pass the swim test. Sliders must ride one at a time. For your safety, sliders must travel feet first and remain on their backs.



Green Monster Tube Slide: A twenty-five foot tunneled inner tube slide taking you on an invigorating ride and plunging into Lagoon Pool at the bottom. Grab an inner tube for yourself or ride with a friend on our two person inner tube. Sliders must be 42" tall or pass the swim test. For your safety, sliders must travel feet first and remain on their backs while on the inner tube.



Lagoon Pool: A twenty-five yard long activity pool with lots of room to play, chat, and swim. Note: Water depth varies from two feet to five feet. There is a swift current in area where sliders enter Lagoon Pool. Weak swimmers must remain in shallow areas with direct supervision.



Larry's Lazy River: Guests of all ages can enjoy the endless flow of the river. However, only strong swimmers dare to partake in the currents of the vortex. Go with the flow or soak up the sun in the river's lounge area. Water depth is three feet throughout this attraction.



Splash & Play Island: This island has it all. Lounge along the beach style entry or romp around in two feet wading area. There are fun filled fountains, tipping buckets, small scale slides, and a gigantic yellow bucket that dumps 500 gallons of water every two minutes. This area is kid and family friendly.



Patch's Splash Pad: This area is coated with blue non-skid surface. Dodge the sprays, dance through the fountains, or sit under the wave of water to cool off from sunbathing or with the littlest tikes. This area is kid and family friendly.

Food and Beverage



THE CORNER MARKET: Cuisine: American Price Range per item: \$1-\$3
Acceptable Payment: Cash only.

This grab-and-go market has a wide selection of munchies to fill your hunger in a hurry. Lunch and dinner options include pizza (pepperoni or cheese), nachos (includes chili and cheese), Frito pie, hot dog (optional chili and cheese), or subs (turkey/ham/club). Wash down lunch with a cool soft drink or an Icee. Flavors of soft drinks offered at SPAR WATERPARK are Coke, Diet Coke, Dr. Pepper, Sprite, Lemonade, Barq's Rootbeer, Minute Maid Lemonade. If you have a sweet or sour tooth, try our selection of candies or a pickle.



VENDING MACHINE: Water, Powerade, Tea Price per item: \$1.50
Acceptable Payment: Cash only.

Flavors of the 20oz beverages are Dasani water, Nestea Lemon Ice Tea, Vault, and four selected flavors of Powerade.



THE HUT: Frozen Minute Maid Lemonade/ Strawberry Lemonade, Subs, chips, and sundries
Price Range per item: \$1-\$3
Acceptable Payment: Cash only.

The HUT is a quick service stand that has what you need to survive in SPAR WATERPARK. Cool off with a Frozen Minute Maid Lemonade or Strawberry Lemonade for only \$3. Freshly prepared 6 inch sub sandwiches topped with your choice of lettuce and cheese are available for only \$3. Add a bag of chips, pretzels, or cheese curls for only a buck. Did you forget your camera? You may purchase a waterproof camera at the HUT as well as, sunscreen, lip balm, waterproof canisters, and more. Gift shop item's price range is \$2-\$12.

Amenities



LOCKERS: It is best to leave valuables at home. Please do not bring valuables into the park or exposed in your vehicle. Lock money and car key in a locker instead of keeping them in pockets where they may fall out in the rides. SPAR WATERPARK is not responsible for items lost or stolen in the park. Lockers are located west wall of entrance building near showers. Lockers are available for rent, \$0.25 each time opened. Another option is to purchase a waterproof canister to keep your keys and money dry and secure.

SHOWERS: Two showers are on deck for patrons to rinse off before/after exiting attractions.

DRESSING ROOMS: Located at front entrance of SPAR WATERPARK. Please take personal items with you onto pool deck or rent a locker.

Water Safety



WATER SAFETY: At SPAR WATERPARK, Guest safety is our primary goal. Highly trained American Red Cross certified Lifeguards patrol the park throughout the day. For your safety, please observe all posted rules and obey lifeguards. Here are a few safety hints:

- Air filled swimming aids give parents and children a false sense of safety and are not permitted at SPAR WATERPARK. However, weak swimmers are encouraged to bring their own Coast-guard approved life vest jacket or preserver. No other flotation devices allowed.
- Children 10 years of age and younger must be directly accompanied by a responsible guardian (16 years of age or older) at all times within SPAR WATERPARK.
- Report all injuries/ emergencies to First Aid Station deck southwest area of park.
